

CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS

Before the beginning of the Conference the scientific articles of all the participants will be published in the conference proceedings.

ISBN will be assigned to the text-based Conference proceedings and it will be published in USA by DiggyPOD Publishing House.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to

- select and edit the article manuscript;
- return materials on completion of authors (if they do not meet the requirements).

Conference proceedings will be assigned to Google Scholar.



PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- 1. Papers must be original and should not be or have been published before the Conference elsewhere.
- 2. Online versions of scientific papers (students or participants without an academic degree should write their scientific supervisor) must be submitted to the Organizing Committee in German, French, English or Polish electronically via email: tneu.rmv.conf@gmail.com.
- 3. All applications for participation in the Conference must be submitted electronically via **Registration form** (QR-code in the lower left corner)
- 4. Papers must be submitted in Microsoft Word format, A4 size paper with 2 cm margins on all sides. The preferred font for the title and text is **Times New Roman**, **12 pt font size**, **between line spacing should be set at 1,5**. Your paper should not include numeration of pages.
- 5. Paper should be no longer than **4-6 pages** and should fully describe the contents of your oral presentation, including figures and tables. Using of illustrative materials in abstracts should be minimal. No more than three co-authors are allowed.
- 6. Author's name, institution/university, city should be typed in bold lower case letters (without shortenings). All author details must be in single-column format and aligned flush with the right-hand margin of the page. The title of your paper should be typed in bold capital letters in the centre. Leave one line of space above and below the title. All these should be written in English.
- 7. Leave one line of space below and write an **abstract** in English and in the language of the paper. The preferred font for an abstract TNR, italic, 10 pt font size.
- 8. Leave one line of space below and write **key words** in English and in the language of the paper. The preferred font for an abstract TNR, italic, 10 pt font size.
- 9. Then comes the main text of conference paper.
- 10. **References** must be numbered consecutively in the order, in which they are mentioned in the text. Number the reference items and pages in square brackets (e.g. [1, p. 44]). References should be given at the end of the paper with bibliography lists of sources in the original language.
- 11. Invitations to participate in the Conference will be sent to the authors on the basis of competitive selection by **05.03.2017**.
- 12. Conference Registration Fee: 10 USD for 1 paper page. Payment details will be sent after the receipt of the application and conference paper of the participant.
