



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## SECTION 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1. This Statute of the higher education institution is developed in accordance with the law and is a document that regulates the activities of the West Ukrainian National University (hereinafter – the University).

1.2. The establishment of the University began in 1966. According to the order of the Minister of Higher and Secondary Special Education of the Ukrainian SSR dated 30.06.1966 No. 418 «About organization of the Department of Finance and Economics of the Kyiv Institute of National Economy» from September 1, 1966, the city of Ternopil organized Department of Finance and Economics of the Kyiv Institute of National economy.

According to the order of the Minister of Higher and Secondary Special Education of the Ukrainian SSR dated 28.08.1967 No. 543 «On the reorganization of the Ternopil branch of the Kyiv Institute National Economy» from September 1, 1967, the Ternopil branch was reorganized to the Ternopil Faculty of the Kyiv Institute of National Economy.

According to the order of the Minister of Higher and Secondary Special Education of the Ukrainian SSR dated 11.12.1970 No. 848 «On the organization of the Ternopil Financial and Economic Institute» on the basis of the Ternopil Faculty of the Kyiv Institute of National Economy named after D. S. Korotchenko organized the Ternopil Financial and Economic Institute.

According to the order of the Ministry of Higher and Secondary Special Education of the Ukrainian SSR dated 11.08.1989 No. 203 «On renaming TFEI» Ternopil Financial Economic Institute was renamed Ternopil Institute of National economy.

According to the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine of August 29, 1994 No. 592 «On improving the network of higher education institutions» on the basis of the Ternopil Institute of National Economy, the Ternopil Academy of National Economy was established. The Ternopil Academy of National Economy is the legal successor of the Ternopil Institute of National Economy.

According to the order of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine of March 30, 2005 No. 72 «On the establishment of the Ternopil State Economic University» on the basis of the Ternopil Academy of National Economy, the Ternopil State Economic University was established. Ternopil State Economic University is the legal successor of Ternopil Academy of National Economy.

According to the Decree of the President of Ukraine of September 29, 2006 No. 794 «About granting the status of the Ternopil State Economic University national» The University was granted national status and renamed to Ternopil National Economic University.

By order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated August 25, 2020 No. 1077 «About renaming of Ternopil National Economic University» Ternopil National Economic University was renamed to West Ukrainian National University.

1.3. The University is a multidisciplinary, classic institution of higher education that conducts educational activities at various levels of higher education (including Doctor of Philosophy), conducts scientific, scientific-technical, innovative and/or methodological activities, ensures the organization of the educational process and obtaining professional pre-higher and higher education, advanced training and lifelong learning, taking into account their callings, interests and abilities.

1.4. The University operates in accordance with the issued license for educational activities at certain levels of higher education.

1.5. The University is a leading scientific and methodological center, has a developed infrastructure of educational, scientific and scientific-production subdivisions, promotes the dissemination of scientific knowledge and conducts fundamental and applied scientific research, carries out innovative, sports, cultural and educational activities.

1.6. The University is an autonomous and self-governing institution of higher education with the status of national, state ownership and belongs to the sphere of management of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

1.10. The University carries out its activities in accordance with the Constitution of Ukraine, Laws of Ukraine «On Education», «On Higher Education», «On Professional Pre-Higher Education», «On Scientific and Scientific-Technical

Activity» and other normative legal acts, international treaties of Ukraine, concluded in accordance with the procedure established by law, and this Statute.

1.11. The University is a legal entity of public law, a budgetary institution, which carries out its activities on the principles of non-profitability.

1.12. The University maintains an independent balance sheet, has special registration accounts, opened in the territorial body of the central executive body in the field treasury servicing of budget funds, as well as current and/or deposit (deposit) accounts in banking institutions, estimates, may acquire property and personal non-property rights and obligations on its own behalf, be a plaintiff and defendant in court.

1.13. The University has a seal with the image of the State Coat of Arms of Ukraine, the name of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, with its name, other seals, forms and stamps with details, own symbols, registered in the established procedure by law, trademarks and other attributes of a legal entity.

1.14. The University has its symbols: the Coat of Arms of the University, the logo of the University, the banner of the University, the banners of faculties, educational and scientific institutes, professional colleges, the mantles of the rector, vice-rector, dean of the faculty, director of the educational and scientific institute, head of the department, Doctor Honoris Causa.

1.15. The University may be the founder (co-founder) of other legal entities that carry out their activities in accordance with the areas of scientific, educational-scientific-production, innovation activities of the University and/or ensure the implementation of its statutory tasks.

1.16. The University may form educational, educational-scientific and educational-scientific-production complexes, a science park and be part of a consortium. All participants of the complex, the consortium retain the status of a legal entity and financial independence.

## SECTION 2. CONCEPT OF EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITY OF THE UNIVERSITY

2.1. The main goal of the educational activity of the University is the preparation of highly qualified and competitive specialists in the national and international labor markets for enterprises of all forms of ownership, scientific and educational institutions, state authorities and administration at all levels of higher education, educational-professional degree of professional junior bachelor on the basis of affirmation national, cultural and universal values.

2.2. The University trains higher education students with a Doctor of Philosophy and scientific degree of Doctor of Science in accordance with the law.

2.3. Educational programs of the University ensure the formation of key competencies needed for self-realization, active citizenship students.

The University independently develops and approves educational programs taking into account requirements for the relevant level of higher education established by law and requirements standards of higher education.

2.4. The University may carry out educational activities jointly with Ukrainian and foreign educational institutions under agreed educational programs.

2.5. Principles of educational activity of the University:

- 1) the indivisibility of the processes of learning, research work, innovative activities and production;
- 2) integration into the European educational space;
- 3) compliance of higher education with the needs of the individual, society, the state;
- 4) equal opportunities for young people in obtaining quality higher education;
- 5) continuing education, provision opportunity permanent deepening general education and professional training and retraining;
- 6) comprehensive development of multi-structure and variability of education, which provides creating opportunities for a wide choice of forms and content of higher education;
- 7) humanism, democracy, patriotism, priority Ukrainian and universal spiritual values;
- 8) ensuring the quality of educational activities and the quality of higher education (system internal quality assurance);
- 9) academic freedom;
- 10) academic integrity;
- 11) integration of education and science through the active use of scientific research and innovative methods in the educational process;
- 12) transparency and publicity in the adoption and implementation of management decisions;
- 13) the formation of an ecological culture and a culture of healthy lifestyle.

2.6. The means of implementing the target programs of educational activity of the University are:

- 1) participation in the development and implementation of the national quality assurance system higher education, the national qualifications framework, state education standards, standards educational activities;
- 2) monitoring of modern trends in the development of the world educational and scientific space for timely response to global threats and changes in conditions and circumstances in the market educational services, the introduction of new scientific and educational technologies;
- 3) expanding the range of educational services by licensing new specialties and opening new educational programs in licensed specialties;
- 4) the formation of educational programs exclusively on a competence basis;
- 5) introduction of intensive personality-oriented learning technologies;
- 6) participation of the University in international academic mobility programs;
- 7) formation of joint educational programs with partner universities;
- 8) integration of the University with educational institutions, scientific institutions and enterprises;
- 9) improving the research component in the educational programs of the University;
- 10) implementation of European standards and principles of quality assurance in education, simultaneously or together with internal and external expertise of educational programs, procedures and evaluation criteria;
- 11) ensuring transparency and accessibility of information about the educational process in University;
- 12) development and implementation of measures necessary for institutional accreditation of the University and its educational programs in European and international associations of universities, the European Association for Quality Assurance in Higher Education;
- 13) participation of the University in international rankings of higher education institutions.

2.7. The implementation of the Concept of Educational Activities of the University is carried out through appropriate personnel, material-technical and financial support.

### SECTION 3. POWERS OF THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND SCIENCE OF UKRAINE

3.1. The Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine realizes the rights and obligations of authorized by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine regarding the University as a central executive body in the field of education and science.

3.2. The University is under the subordination and management of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

3.3. The powers of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine regarding management of the University are determined by the Law of Ukraine "On Higher Education" and other laws of Ukraine, as well as this Statute.

3.4. Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine:

1) approves the statute of the University and, upon submission by the labor collective conference of the University, amends it or approves a new version;

2) concludes a contract with the rector of the University, elected for a monthly term by competition in the manner established by the Law of Ukraine "On Higher Education";

3) terminates early the contract with the rector of the University upon submission by the labor collective conference of the University on the grounds defined by labor law, or for violation of the statute of the University and the terms of the contract;

4) exercises control over the financial and economic activities of the University;

5) exercises control over compliance with the statute of the University;

6) exercises other powers provided for by law and the statute of the University.

3.5. The Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine may delegate some of its powers to the rector of the University.

## SECTION 4. TASKS, RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY

4.1. The main tasks of the University are:

1) carrying out educational activities at a high level, which ensures the acquisition of higher education by persons of the appropriate degree in their chosen specialties;

2) carrying out scientific activities through scientific research, training of highly qualified scientific personnel and use of the results obtained in educational process;

3) participation in ensuring the social and economic development of the state through human capital formation;

4) formation of personality through patriotic, legal, environmental education, affirmation of moral values, social activity, civic position and responsibility, healthy lifestyle, ability to think creatively and self-organize in modern conditions;

5) ensuring the organic combination of educational, scientific and innovation activity;

6) creating the necessary conditions for the realization by participants in the educational process of their abilities and talents;

7) preservation and multiplication of moral, cultural, scientific values and achievements of society;

8) dissemination of knowledge among the population, raising the educational and cultural level citizens;

9) establishing international relations and conducting international activities in the field of education, science, sports, arts and culture;

10) studying the demand for certain specialties in the labor market and promoting employment of graduates.

4.2. The University's activities are based on the principles of:

1) autonomy and self-government;

- 2) delimitation of rights, powers and responsibilities of the Ministry of Education and Science in Ukraine, the governing bodies of the University and its structural subdivisions;
- 3) combination of collegial and sole management principles;
- 4) independence from political parties, public and religious organizations.

4.3. The University has the rights that constitute the content of its autonomy and self-government, including:

- 1) independently or together with other educational institutions, scientific institutions, enterprises, other legal entities to develop and implement educational programs within the license, determine the relevant specializations, subject specialties;
- 2) independently determine the forms of education, forms of organization of the educational process and types of educational activities;
- 3) hire scientific and pedagogical, scientific, pedagogical and other employees;
- 4) choose the types of bachelor's and master's degree programs provided for in the International Standard Classification of Education;
- 5) form and approve its own staffing table in accordance with legislation. If the number of persons studying under each educational program decreases within 20 percent of the number determined at the beginning of training under this program, the staff number of scientific and pedagogical staff is not reduced;
- 6) make a final decision on the recognition, including the establishment of equivalence, of bachelor's, master's degrees obtained in foreign higher education institutions, Doctor of Philosophy, Doctor of Science and academic titles of Associate Professor, Professor when enrolling in training and/or to the position of scientific and pedagogical or scientific employee;
- 7) recognize the learning outcomes obtained under educational programs professional pre-higher and higher education, the results of academic mobility in a defined University procedure;
- 8) recognize the learning outcomes obtained through non-formal and informal education, in accordance with the procedure approved by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine;

9) introduce rating evaluation, other methods of evaluation and motivation educational, research and innovation achievements of participants in the educational process;

10) provide additional educational and other services in accordance with the law;

11) independently develop and implement their own programs of educational, scientific, scientific, technical and innovative activities;

12) independently introduce specializations, subject specialties, determine content and programs of educational components;

13) award educational and professional qualifications to higher education students who have successfully passed the certification procedures provided for by law after completion training under the relevant educational programs;

14) make decisions in accordance with the law on awarding and depriving degrees of Doctor of Philosophy, independently form one-time specialized scientific councils;

15) establish institutions of general secondary education in agreement with the authorities local self-government;

16) act as a founder or co-founder of vocational (vocational-technical), professional pre-higher education, colleges;

17) create, reorganize and liquidate their structural subdivisions;

18) conduct publishing activities, including the publication of textbooks, educational manuals and scientific works, educational and methodological materials, as well as develop their own printing base;

19) carry out, on the basis of relevant agreements, joint activities with institutions of education, scientific institutions and other legal entities in the established procedure established by law;

20) place their educational, research, educational-scientific and educational-scientific-production units at enterprises, institutions and organizations;

21) participate in the work of international organizations;

22) introduce their own symbols and attributes;

23) establish their own forms of moral and material incentives

for participants in the educational process;

24) take the initiative to the bodies that manage higher education education on making changes to existing or developing new regulatory legal acts in the field of higher education, as well as participate in the work on projects;

25) carry out financial and economic and other activities in accordance with legislation and this Statute;

26) manage own income, in particular from the provision of paid services;

27) form innovative structures of various types on its base (scientific and technological parks, business incubators, small enterprises, etc.) on the basis of combining interests of high-tech companies, science, education, business and the state in order to implementation and implementation of innovative projects;

28) establish standards for the number of students per position of scientific-pedagogical and pedagogical worker;

29) independently determine the items and amounts of expenses of own funds;

30) exercise other rights that do not contradict the law. 4.4. The University is obliged to:

1) take measures, including through the introduction of appropriate modern technologies, to prevent and detect academic plagiarism in scientific works scientific and pedagogical, scientific, pedagogical and other employees and bringing them to disciplinary responsibility;

2) have an internal system of quality assurance of higher education, including approved policy to ensure compliance by participants in the educational process academic integrity (code of academic integrity);

3) create the necessary conditions for obtaining higher education by persons with special educational needs;

4) publish on the official website, on information stands and in any other way information about the realization of their rights and fulfillment of obligations;

5) carry out educational activities on the principles of student-centered learning.

## SECTION 5. STRUCTURE OF THE UNIVERSITY

5.1. The structure of the University, the status and functions of its structural units are determined by this Statute and the regulations on the relevant structural units.

5.2. The decision on the formation (reorganization, liquidation) of structural units of the University is approved by the Academic Council of the University in the manner determined by the Law of Ukraine "On Higher Education" and this Statute.

5.3. The main structural units of the University are faculties, departments, L. Kanishchenko Library.

5.4. The structural subdivisions of the University are: educational and scientific institutes, professional colleges, units that provide the educational process and scientific activities, administrative and economic units that ensure the implementation of statutory activities of the University, etc.

5.5. Territorially separated structural units of the University in the form of institutes, colleges, faculties, departments, etc. are created in order to satisfy the needs of the regional labor market in relevant specialists and bringing the place of study closer applicants of higher education to their place of residence.

Territorially separated structural units of the University are not legal persons and act on the basis of the regulations approved by the University and in accordance with the received license for educational activities. They are headed by managers who are subordinate to the rector of the University and act on the basis of the relevant power of attorney.

Information about such units of the University is entered into the Unified State electronic database on education issues. Territorially separated structural units of The University carry out educational activities according to its own educational programs.

#### 5.7. The University includes professional colleges:

Separate structural subdivision "Professional College of Economics, Law and Information Technologies of West Ukrainian National University" (code according to USREOU VP: 37753993; location: Peremohy Square, building 3, Ternopil, Ukraine, 46009);

Separate structural subdivision "Chortkiv Professional College of Economics and Entrepreneurship of West Ukrainian National University" (code according to USREOU VP: 37417766; location: Stepana Bandery Street, building 46, Chortkiv, Ternopil region, Ukraine, 46500);

Separate structural subdivision "Vinnytsia Professional College of Economics and Entrepreneurship of West Ukrainian National University" (code according to USREOU VP: 38417484; location: Honty Street, building 37, Vinnytsia, Ukraine, 21017).

Separate structural subdivision "Yerevan Professional College of West Ukrainian National University" (location: Acharyana Street, building 31, Avan, Yerevan, Republic of Armenia).

Professional colleges of the University as separate structural subdivisions of the University carry out educational activities related to obtaining professional pre-higher education, may conduct research and/or sports activities, ensure the combination of theoretical training with training in workplaces. Professional colleges have the right, in accordance with the license(s), to ensure the acquisition of specialized secondary

education professional and academic orientation, professional (vocational-technical) and/or initial level (short cycle) of higher education and/or the first (bachelor's) level of higher education in accordance with the law.

Professional colleges of the University have powers, rights, obligations, goals, tasks and principles of activity provided for by the Law of Ukraine "On Professional Pre-Higher Education" and other laws of Ukraine for an institution of professional pre-higher education, if their right to carry out educational activities in the field of professional pre-higher education is specified in the license of the University and if the main activity of the professional college is educational activity in the field of professional pre-higher education.

In order to achieve the goals and objectives, the University's professional colleges are granted separate rights of financial and economic independence: the right to maintain a separate balance sheet, opening a registration account with the State Treasury Service, having a seal and stamp with its own name, etc.

Professional colleges of the University operate on the basis of regulations. The director of the professional college reports to the rector of the University and acts on the basis of relevant instructions.

5.8. The structural subdivisions of the University may include:

1) scientific, educational-scientific, research, scientific-production and project institutes, educational-scientific, educational-scientific-production centers (sectors, parts, complexes, etc.), research stations, design bureaus, department of postgraduate studies and doctoral studies, educational and production plants, experimental enterprises, legal clinics, training grounds, science parks, technology parks, museums, other units that ensure practical training of specialists in certain specialties and/or conduct scientific research;

2) preparatory departments (units), units of retraining and advanced training training of personnel, institutes of postgraduate education, laboratories, training laboratories, educational and methodological offices, computer and information centers, educational production and creative workshops, educational and research production farms, production structures, publishing houses, sports complexes, cultural and consumer facilities purposes, student sports centers;

3) a special educational and rehabilitation unit, which is created for the purpose of organization of inclusive educational process and special educational and rehabilitation support for higher education students with

special educational needs, ensuring their access to quality higher education, taking into account the limitations of life;

- 4) other units whose activities are not prohibited by law.

5.9. The University includes structural units of social and cultural sphere, which ensure the operation of social and cultural facilities purposes, in particular: international center of culture and development, museum of University history, student campus, educational and scientific center of student sports, educational and scientific center of recreation and health improvement, department of creative self-organization and education and others.

## SECTION 6. UNIVERSITY MANAGEMENT

### 1.1. Rector of the University

1.1.1. The rector directly manages the activities of the University. His rights, duties and responsibilities are determined by law, this Statute and contract.

1.1.2. The Rector represents the University in relations with state bodies, local self-government bodies, legal entities and individuals and acts without power of attorney within the powers provided by the Law of Ukraine "On Higher Education" and this Statute.

1.1.3. The Rector of the University within the powers granted to him:

- 1) organizes the activities of the University;
- 2) decides on issues of financial and economic activity of the University, approves its structure and staffing;
- 3) issues orders and instructions, gives instructions that are binding on all participants of the educational process and structural subdivisions of the University;
- 4) is responsible for the results of the University's activities to the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine;
- 5) is the manager of property and funds;
- 6) ensures the implementation of the financial plan (estimate), concludes contracts;
- 7) appoints and dismisses employees;
- 8) defines the official (functional) and work duties of employees;
- 9) ensures labor protection, compliance with law and order;

10) forms the contingent of persons studying at the University;

11) expels from the University and renews the education of higher education applicants with agreement with student self-government bodies and primary trade union organizations of persons who study (if this person is a member of the trade union), on the grounds established by the Law of Ukraine "On Higher Education";

12) ensures the organization and implementation of control over the implementation of educational plans and programs of academic disciplines;

13) monitors compliance by all departments of the University with staffing and financial discipline;

14) monitors the quality of work of scientific and pedagogical, scientific, pedagogical and other employees;

15) ensures the creation of conditions for the implementation of effective and open public control over the activities of the University;

16) promotes and creates conditions for the activities of student self-government bodies, organizations of trade unions of employees of the University and students, public organizations, operating at the University;

17) promotes the formation of a healthy lifestyle among higher education students, strengthening the sports and recreation base of the University, creates appropriate conditions for classes mass sports;

18) jointly with the elected bodies of primary organizations of trade unions of employees of the University and students submits for approval to the conference of the labor collective University Rules of Internal Regulations and Collective Agreement, after which he signs them;

19) applies measures of moral and material incentives for employees of the University, brings them to disciplinary responsibility in accordance with legislation;

20) establishes the amount of allowances, bonuses, premiums, financial assistance and incentives for scientific and pedagogical, scientific, pedagogical and other employees of the University in accordance with the law;

21) organizes and controls the implementation of statutory and contractual obligations of the University;

22) exercises other powers provided by law and this Statute.

1.1.4. The Rector is responsible for the implementation of educational, scientific, scientific and technical and innovation activities at the University, for the results of financial and economic activities, the condition and preservation of real estate and other property of the University.

1.1.5. The Rector of the University reports annually to the conference of the labor collective of the University and the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

The annual report of the rector should contain information on the level of achievement of the target performance indicators of the University, defined by the contract and the Development Strategy of the University, as of December 31 of the year for which the report was prepared, and is subject to inclusion in the Unified State Electronic Database on Education and is published in the Register of subjects of educational activity of the Unified State Electronic Database on Education and on the official website of the University.

1.1.6. The Rector may delegate part of his powers to vice-rectors and heads of structural divisions. Vice-rectors are appointed to positions by the rector of the University with agreement with the student self-government body of the University

1.1.7. In the absence of the Rector of the University, the performance of his duties is assigned to the first vice-rector or one of the vice-rectors.

1.1.8. The Rector of the University is elected by secret ballot for a term of five years in the manner prescribed by the Law of Ukraine "On Higher Education" and this Statute.

1.1.9. Elections of the Rector of the University are held in compliance with the principles of openness, transparency, secret and free expression of will, voluntary participation in elections, democracy, ensuring equal rights of election participants.

1.1.10. A candidate for the position of Rector of the University must be fluent in the state language in accordance with the level determined by the National Commission on Standards of the state language, have an academic title and a scientific degree and work experience in positions of scientific and pedagogical workers for at least 10 years. Candidate for the position of Rector The University must be a citizen of Ukraine.

The same person cannot be the rector of the University for more than two terms.

1.1.11. A person who cannot be elected, appointed (including as acting) to the position of rector of the University:

- 1) is recognized by a court as incompetent or whose capacity is limited;

2) has a criminal record for committing a criminal offense, if such conviction has not been expunged or removed in accordance with the procedure established by law;

3) is deprived of the right to hold relevant positions according to a court verdict;

4) has been found guilty by a court of committing a corruption offense - within one year from the date the relevant court decision enters into legal force;

5) has been subjected to administrative penalties for a corruption offense - within one year from the date the relevant court decision enters into legal force;

6) falls under part 3 of Article 1 of the Law of Ukraine "On Purification of Power".

1.1.12. The Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine announces a competition for the position of rector of the University no later than two months before the expiration of the contract of the person who holds this position. In case of early termination of the powers of the rector of the University, the competition is announced within a week from the date of vacancy.

1.1.13. The Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine within two months from the date of announcement of the competition for the position of rector of the University accepts proposals for candidates for the position of rector and within 10 days from the date of completion of the submission of relevant proposals submits the candidatures of candidates who meet the requirements of the Law of Ukraine "On Higher Education" to the University for voting.

1.1.14. The peculiarities of the electoral system, the procedure for electing the rector and the standard form of contract with the rector are determined by the Law of Ukraine "On Higher Education" and methodological recommendations approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine.

1.1.15. The following have the right to participate in the election of the rector of the University:

1) each scientific-pedagogical, scientific and pedagogical full-time employee;

2) representatives from among other full-time employees who are elected by the relevant employees through direct secret ballot;

3) elected representatives from among students who are elected by students through direct secret ballot.

At the same time, the total number (full composition) of scientific-pedagogical, scientific, pedagogical staff of the University should be at least 75 percent of the total number of persons who have the right to participate in the elections; the number of elected representatives from among other employees of the University - up to 10 percent, and the number of elected representatives from among students - at least 15 percent of the persons who have the right to participate in the elections.

1.1.16. The elections are considered valid if more than 50 percent of the total number of people eligible to participate in the elections took part, each of whom has one vote and votes in person.

If two or more persons (candidates) participated in the elections, and none of them received more than 50 percent of the votes of persons eligible to participate in the elections, on the seventh calendar day after the first round, a second round is held elections.

The ballots for the second round of elections include two persons (candidates) who received the most votes in the first round.

A person (candidate) who has collected more than 50 percent of the votes of persons eligible to participate in the elections is considered elected as the rector of the University, and in the event of the second round - more than 50 percent of the votes of those who participated in voting.

1.1.17. With the person (candidate) elected as the rector of the University in accordance with the requirements of the Law of Ukraine "On Higher Education", the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine concludes a contract for a term of five years no later than one month from the date of its election, determining in the contract the target indicators of the University's activity, the achievement of which must ensure the person (candidate) in the position of rector of the University in case of signing the contract, the mechanisms for verifying the achievement of such target indicators, as well as the terms for achieving such target indicators.

If a person (candidate) elected as the rector of the University in accordance with the law has not passed a special check, the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine announces a new one within seven calendar days after the end of the special check competition for the position of rector of the University.

If the elections are declared invalid, or if none of the persons (candidates) did not receive the required number of votes, a new competition for the position of rector is announced within a week from the date of establishment election results University.

1.1.18. The rector of the University may be dismissed from his post by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, as well as in connection with the adoption of a decision on his recall by the conference of the labor collective of the University, on the grounds determined by law on labor, for violation of the charter of the University and the terms of the contract. Submission about the recall of the rector may be submitted to the conference of the labor collective University by at least half of the Supervisory or Academic Council of the University.

The decision to recall the rector of the University is made by a majority vote provided that at least two-thirds of the conference of the labor collective are present University.

1.1.19. After retirement from the position of rector of the University, a person who worked in this position for at least 10 consecutive years may be appointed as an advisor to the rector of the University on a voluntary basis or at the expense of the University's own revenues. The salary of the rector's advisor at the University is set at the amount of the official salary of the rector that was in effect on the date of dismissal from the position of rector. A person working in the position of The Rector's Advisor of the University is entitled to the establishment of additional payments and allowances mandatory and incentive nature, provided by law. The advisor of The Rector is covered by the system of material incentives for employees that introduced at the University in accordance with the collective agreement.

1.2. Head of the faculty, educational and scientific institute, professional college, department, library

1.2.1. The faculty is managed by the dean, the educational and scientific institute, professional college, library - director, department management - manager.

1.2.2. The rights, duties and responsibilities of the head of the faculty, educational scientific institute, professional college, department, library are determined by law, regulations on the relevant structural units and regulations University documents.

1.2.3. Features of the election (appointment) of the head of the faculty, educational scientific institute, professional college, department, library are determined by law, the Procedure for conducting a competitive selection for filling vacant positions positions of scientific and pedagogical workers and the conclusion of employment contracts with them (contracts).

1.2.4. The head of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) must have a scientific degree and/or academic (honorary) title, as a rule, according to the profile faculty (educational and scientific institute).

1.2.5. The dean of the faculty, the director of the educational and scientific institute may delegate part of their powers to their deputies. Powers of the head of the

faculty (educational and scientific institute) are determined by the regulations on the faculty (educational scientific institute).

1.2.6. The dean of the faculty, the director of the educational and scientific institute issues orders on the activities of the relevant faculty (educational and scientific institute), which are binding on all participants in the educational process of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) and may be canceled by the rector of the University, if they contradict the law, this Statute or harm the interests of University.

1.2.7. The Rector of the University, with the consent of the majority of the full composition of the labor

The team of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) of the University appoints the head of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) for a term of up to five years and concludes with him a contract.

1.2.8. The head of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) may be dismissed from the position by the rector of the University upon the submission of the Academic Council of the University or the meeting of the labor collective of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) on the grounds determined by the legislation on labor, this Statute, the terms of the contract.

A proposal to dismiss the head of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) is submitted to the meeting of the labor collective of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) not less than half of the votes of the Academic Council of the faculty (educational and scientific institute). A proposal to dismiss the head of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) is accepted by at least two-thirds of the votes of the meeting of the labor collective of the faculty (educational and scientific institute).

1.2.9. Appointment and dismissal from the position of the head of a territorially separated structural subdivision of the University are carried out in the manner established for the head of the faculty (educational and scientific institute).

1.2.10. The same person cannot be the head of the faculty (educational and scientific institute), professional college of the University for more than 10 years.

1.2.11. The head of the department must have a scientific degree and/or academic (honorary) title according to the profile of the department. The head of the department cannot hold the position for more than two terms.

1.2.12. The head of the department is elected by competition by secret ballot of the Academic Council of the University for a term of five years, taking into account the proposals of the labor collective of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) and the department. Rector of the University concludes a contract with the elected head of the department.

1.2.13. The head of the department ensures the organization of the educational process, the implementation of curricula and programs of academic disciplines; monitors the quality of teaching academic disciplines, educational-methodical and scientific activities teachers.

1.2.14. The director of the library is elected by competition by the Academic Council of the University for a term of five years from among the full-time employees for whom the University is the main place of work, taking into account the proposals of the meeting of the library staff.

### 1.3. Academic Council

1.3.1. Collegial management of the University is carried out by the Academic Council of the University (hereinafter – the Academic Council) within its powers.

1.3.2. The Academic Council is formed for a term of five years. Composition of the Academic Council is approved by the order of the Rector of the University within five working days from the date of the expiration of the powers of the previous composition of the Academic Council.

1.3.3. The Academic Council is headed by its chairman, who is elected by secret ballot from among members of the Academic Council who have a scientific degree and/or academic (honorary) title, for a term of activities of the Academic Council.

1.3.4. The Academic Council includes, ex officio, the Rector of the University, the first Vice-Rector, Vice-Rectors, heads of faculties (educational and scientific institutes), academic secretary, library director, chief accountant, heads of self-government bodies and elected bodies of primary trade union organizations of University employees, as well as elected representatives representing scientific and pedagogical, scientific employees and are elected from among heads of departments, professors, doctors of philosophy, doctors of sciences, elected representatives representing other employees of the University and who work in it on a permanent basis, elected representatives of graduate students, doctoral students, students, assistant trainees, heads of elected bodies of primary trade union organizations of students and graduate students, heads of student bodies self-government of the University in accordance with the quotas defined by this Statute.

1.3.5. Elected representatives from among the employees of the University are elected by a conference of the labor collective upon submission by the structural units in which they work, and elected representatives from among students and graduate students are elected by students (graduate students) through direct secret elections.

1.3.6. By the decision of the Academic Council, its composition may also include representatives of employers' organizations. At the same time, at least 75 percent of the composition of the Academic Council must be scientific and

pedagogical, scientific employees of the University and at least 10 percent - elected representatives from among students.

1.3.7. The Academic Council:

- 1) defines the strategy and promising directions of development of educational, scientific and innovation activities of the University;
- 2) submits to the conference of the labor collective of the University a draft statute of the University, as well as decisions on amendments and additions to it;
- 3) approves the financial plan and annual financial report of the University;
- 4) defines the system and approves the procedures for internal quality assurance higher education;
- 5) approves, upon submission by the Rector of the University, decisions on the formation, reorganization and liquidation of structural units;
- 6) makes decisions on placing own revenues in territorial bodies of the central executive body in the field of treasury services budget funds, or in banking institutions;
- 7) approves decisions on the organization of the educational process, determines the terms of study at the appropriate levels;
- 8) approves the Regulations on the organization of the educational process, educational programs and curricula for each level of higher education and specialty;
- 9) approves the Rules of Admission to the University, approves the Procedure for conducting a competitive selection for filling vacant positions of scientific and pedagogical employees and concluding employment contracts (contracts) with them and other provisions on university activities;
- 10) approves the sample and procedure for the production of documents on higher education, including including joint and double diplomas;
- 11) elects by competition by secret ballot to the positions of heads of departments, professors, associate professors;
- 12) approves the candidacies of University employees for governmental, departmental awards and awarding honorary titles;

13) approves candidates for the titles of "Honorary Professor University", "Honorary Employee of the University";

14) establishes nominal scholarships and scholarships of the Academic Council of the University, recommends candidates for nominal and special scholarships;

15) approves the main directions of scientific research and innovation activities;

16) evaluates the scientific and pedagogical activities of structural units;

17) awards academic titles of professor, associate professor and senior researcher and submits relevant decisions for approval to the attestation board of the Ministry of Education and Science Ukraine;

18) approves the individual plan of scientific work and the topic of the dissertation of applicants higher education degree of Doctor of Philosophy;

19) considers the conclusions regarding each applicant to the doctoral studies of the University, approves the topic of the dissertation (scientific report), decides on his enrollment to the University for preparation in doctoral studies and appoints a doctoral student to a scientific consultant;

20) makes decisions on the expulsion of a doctoral student of the University for non-compliance individual plan of scientific work, in particular, violation of the terms of its implementation without valid reasons, violation of the terms of the contract or violation of academic integrity;

21) makes final decisions on the recognition of foreign documents on higher

education, scientific degrees and academic titles during employment of scientific and pedagogical, scientific, pedagogical and other employees, as well as during the enrollment of applicants for training;

22) has the right to submit a proposal to recall the Rector of the University on the grounds provided by law, this Statute, the contract, which is considered at the conference of the University's labor collective;

23) may delegate part of its powers to the scientific councils of faculties (educational and scientific institutes);

24) considers other issues of the University's activities in accordance with the law and this Statute.

1.3.8. Regular meetings of the Academic Council are held, as a rule, monthly. Extraordinary meetings of the Academic Council may be convened at the initiative of the Rector, the Chairman of the Academic Council or at the request of at least one third of the members of the Academic Council.

1.3.9. A meeting of the Academic Council is valid if at least two-thirds of its personal composition participate in it. The decision of the Academic Council is considered adopted, if a majority of the members of the Academic Council who participated in the voting.

1.3.10. Decisions of the Academic Council are put into effect by order of the Rector of the University.

1.3.11. The activity of the Academic Council is regulated by law, this Statute and Regulations on the Academic Council.

1.3.12. Scientific councils of faculties (educational and scientific institutes), the powers of which are determined by the Academic Council of the University in accordance with this Statute. The composition of the relevant academic councils is formed on the same principles as the Academic Council.

1.3.13. Scientific councils of faculties (educational and scientific institutes) are formed for a term of 5 years. The Academic Council of the Faculty (Educational and Scientific Institute) is headed by its chairman, who is elected for the period of activity of the academic council of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) at its meeting by secret ballot. A meeting of the academic council of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) is valid if at least two-thirds of its personal composition participate in it. The decision is considered adopted if more than half of the members of the academic council present voted for it.

1.3.14. The rector, upon submission by the head of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) issues an order on the composition of the academic council of the faculty (educational and scientific institute).

1.3.15. The powers of the academic council of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) include:

- 1) issues of educational-methodical, scientific-research, educational and economic activities of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) and its material and technical support;

- 2) hearing reports from heads of departments, chairmen of councils and commissions, graduate students,

doctoral students, scientific and pedagogical, scientific, pedagogical staff of the faculty (educational and scientific institute);

- 3) consideration of educational programs and curricula, approval of the financial plan and report of the faculty (educational and scientific institute), reports on the implementation of scientific research works;
- 4) initiation of research and economic works aimed at to improve educational, scientific and methodological work;
- 5) making decisions on issues delegated by the Academic Council.

1.3.16. The academic council of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) elects by competition by secret ballot for the positions of assistants, lecturers, senior lecturers, after consideration of the candidates by the relevant departments.

1.3.17. Decisions of the academic council of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) are introduced into effect by order of the head of the faculty (educational and scientific institute). Decision the academic council of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) may be canceled by the Academic council.

1.3.18. Activities of the academic council of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) is regulated by the Regulations on the Academic Council of the Faculty (Educational and Scientific Institute) and this Statute.

#### 1.4. Supervisory Board

1.4.1. In order to supervise the management of the University's property, compliance the purpose of its creation, a supervisory board of the University is created and operates at the University (hereinafter – the Supervisory Board).

1.4.2. The Supervisory Board of the University is created by the decision of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine. The personal composition of the Supervisory Board is approved by the Ministry Education and Science of Ukraine. The term of office of the Supervisory Board is five years. To the Supervisory Board may not include higher education students and employees University.

1.4.3. The Supervisory Board promotes:

- 1) solving strategic tasks of the University's development;
- 2) attracting financial resources to ensure the University's activities from the main directions of development and control over their use;
- 3) effective interaction of the University with state bodies and bodies local self-government, the scientific community, socio-political organizations and business entities in the interests of development and improvement the quality of educational activities and the competitiveness of the University;

4) consideration and analysis of priority directions of the University's development in the fields of education, scientific, scientific-technical and innovative activities;

5) providing assistance to the University in improving the material and technical base of the educational process, scientific and scientific-technical activities, its social infrastructure;

6) integration of the University into the international educational system, searching for ways to expand and improve the international cooperation of the University;

7) forming a positive image of the University in the field of higher education, science and culture at the regional and national levels;

1.4.4. The Supervisory Board of the University has the right to:

1) submit to the conference of the labor collective of the University and/or the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine a submission on the recall of the rector on the grounds provided for by law, this Statute, contract;

2) receive, in accordance with the established procedure, from the rector of the University and the heads

of structural subdivisions information and materials necessary for the performance of the tasks assigned to it;

3) form coordination commissions, expert and working groups on issues of ensuring and scientific and organizational support for the implementation of its powers, involve domestic and foreign scientists, experts and specialists (with their consent) in the work of such commissions (groups);

4) involve specialists from central, local executive authorities and self-government, enterprises and institutions (in agreement with their managers) to examinations and consideration of issues within their competence;

5) conduct conferences, seminars, meetings on issues that are within its competence, in accordance with the established procedure;

6) provide recommendations to the Academic Council and the rectorate of the University regarding ways and methods of improving its statutory activities;

7) inform the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine about the state of activity and level of management efficiency of the University, to make proposals for taking measures to eliminate identified violations;

8) highlight its activities in the mass media, publish the results of its work at meetings, conferences, special stands, official websites.

6.4.5. The Supervisory Board of the University is headed by its chairman, who bears personal responsibility for the performance of the tasks assigned to the Supervisory Board. Chairman of the Supervisory Board of the University determines the functional responsibilities of the deputy, secretary and members of the Supervisory Board; plans and coordinates the work of the Supervisory Board; convenes and conducts its regular and extraordinary (at the suggestion of members of the Supervisory Board) meetings; forms a report on activities of the Supervisory Board, which is approved at a meeting of the Supervisory Board; represents the Supervisory Board in state and public institutions, at enterprises and in organizations; performs other powers and functions in accordance with the tasks assigned to the Supervisory Board.

6.4.6. The main form of work of the Supervisory Board is its meeting. Meeting Supervisory Board meetings are usually convened at least once a year. Date and place the meeting is determined by the chairman of the Supervisory Board.

6.4.7. The Supervisory Board, within its powers, makes decisions, organizes and monitors their implementation.

6.4.8. Decisions of the Supervisory Board, adopted within its competence, are binding for execution by all structural subdivisions of the University. Meeting of the Supervisory Board of the University is authorized if at least two-thirds are present at its full membership of the council. The decision of the Supervisory Board of the University is considered adopted, if more than 50 percent of the total number of the council voted for it. Consideration of questions of the Supervisory Board and the decisions taken are recorded in the minutes of meetings, which signed by the chairman and secretary of the Supervisory Board.

6.4.9. Decisions of the Supervisory Board of the University are brought to the attention within 5 days to the attention of the rectorate of the University and are mandatory for consideration and implementation of relevant measures.

6.4.10. Organizational and logistical support of the Supervisory Board of the University is carried out by the University, which provides premises, computer and organizational technique.

## **6.5. Working and advisory bodies**

6.5.1. Working bodies are formed at the University to resolve current issues of activity working bodies - rectorate, dean's offices of faculties, directorates of educational and scientific institutes, professional colleges, admissions committee, competition committee, certification committee, scholarship committees, etc.

6.5.2. In order to develop a strategy and directions for the implementation of educational and/or scientific activities of the University, the rector has the right to form on a voluntary basis advisory (advisory and consultative) bodies: scientific and methodological council, scientific and technical council, employers' council, investors' council, business council, student council, etc.

6.5.3. Regulations on working and advisory (advisory and consultative) bodies The University is approved by the Academic Council. Composition of working and advisory (advisory consultative) bodies is approved by the rector of the University.

6.5.4. The rectorate decides on current issues of educational, scientific, educational, economic and financial activities of the University, develops and submits for consideration by the Academic The University Council's proposals for resolving issues within its competence.

6.5.5. The Rectorate is headed by the Rector of the University. The Rectorate includes Vice-Rectors, Heads of Faculties (Educational and Scientific Institutes) and Heads of other structural subdivisions. The Rector of the University approves the personal composition of the Rectorate.

6.5.6. Other persons may be invited to the Rectorate meetings. The Rector convenes the Rectorate meeting and conducts it.

6.5.7. Decisions are made on issues considered by the Rectorate. Rectorate decisions are put into effect by orders of the Rector.

6.5.8. Dean's offices of faculties (directorates of educational and scientific institutes, professional colleges) organize and coordinate educational, scientific, methodological and economic activities of departments of faculties (educational and scientific institutes), cycle commissions of professional college. The Dean's Office (Directorate) is headed by the Head of the Faculty (Educational Scientific Institute, Professional College).

The procedure for the formation, composition and powers of the dean's offices of faculties (directorates of educational and scientific institutes, professional colleges) are determined in the Regulations on the faculty (educational and scientific institute, professional college), which is approved by the Academic Council of the University.

6.5.8. The Admissions Committee forms the contingent of applicants for professional pre-higher and higher education of the University in all forms of education, as well as doctoral students of the University. Composition of the admissions committee is approved by the rector, who is its chairman. Term of office of the admissions committee - one year. The Admissions Committee before the end of the term of office reports on the results of its activities to the Academic Council of the University.

6.6. Bodies of public self-government of the University

6.6.1. The highest collegial body of public self-government of the University is the conference of the labor collective of the University, including elected representatives from among students.

6.6.2. The procedure for convening and making decisions by the conference of the labor collective of the university is determined by this Statute.

6.6.3. Conference of the labor collective of the University:

1) agrees on the statute of the University or changes (additions) to it submitted by the Academic Council;

2) hears annually the report of the rector on the results of educational and scientific work, financial and economic activities and tasks of the University for the next academic year and evaluates its activities;

3) elects a commission on labor disputes in accordance with labor legislation;

4) elects elected representatives to the Academic Council upon submission of structural subdivisions where they work;

5) considers, based on a reasoned submission from the Supervisory or Academic Council, the issue of early termination of the Rector of the University's powers on the grounds provided for by law, contract;

6) approves the Internal Regulations of the University;

7) considers and approves the collective agreement, decides to grant the chairman of the trade union committee of the primary trade union organization the authority to sign it on behalf of the labor collective and hears a report on the implementation of the collective agreement;

8) makes decisions on other issues of the University's activities in accordance with legislation and this Statute;

6.6.4. The conference of the labor collective of the University is convened at least once a year. The decision to convene a conference of the labor collective of the University is made by the Academic Council.

6.6.5. All categories of participants in the educational process of the University must be represented at the conference of the labor collective of the University. At the same time, at least 75 percent of the delegates (members) of the conference of the labor collective of the University must be scientific and pedagogical, scientific and pedagogical staff of the University, who work at the University on a permanent basis, and at least 15 percent - elected representatives from among students, who are elected by students through direct secret elections.

6.6.6. The number of delegates to the conference of the labor collective of the University and the norms (quotas) of representation of delegates from each structural subdivision of the University are established by the Academic Council. Delegates to the conference of the labor collective of the University from University employees are elected for a term of five years. Delegates to the conference of the labor collective of the University from students of the University are elected for a term of one year.

6.6.7. The conference of the labor collective of the University is considered authorized if at least two-thirds of the total number of elected delegates are present at it. Decisions of the conference of the labor collective of the University are adopted by a simple majority of votes of the delegates present.

Issues of preparation and holding of the conference of the labor collective of the University are determined by the regulation approved by the Academic Council.

6.6.8. The body of public self-government of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) is the meeting of the labor collective of the faculty (educational and scientific institute), including elected representatives from among persons studying at the faculty (in the educational and scientific institute).

6.6.9. The procedure for convening meetings of the labor collective of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) and its activities are determined by this Statute. Meetings of the labor the faculty (educational and scientific institute) staff is convened at least once a year.

6.6.10. At the meeting of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) staff all categories of faculty employees (educational and scientific institute) and elected representatives from among the persons studying at the faculty (in educational and scientific institute). At the same time, at least 75 percent of the delegates of the meeting of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) staff must be scientific and pedagogical and scientific employees of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) and at least 15 percent - elected representatives from among the students covered by student self-government and elected by students through direct secret elections.

6.6.11. Meeting of the faculty (educational and scientific institute) staff:

- 1) evaluate the activities of the head of the faculty (educational and scientific institute);

- 2) approve the annual report on the activities of the faculty (educational and scientific institute);

- 3) submit proposals to the Rector of the University regarding the recall from the position of the head of the faculty (educational and scientific

institute) on the grounds provided for by law, the charter of the University, the contract concluded with him;

4) elect elected representatives to the scientific council of the faculty (educational scientific institute);

5) elect delegates to the conference of the University staff;

6) elect candidates to the Scientific Council of the University.

6.6.12. The composition of delegates of the general meeting of the staff of professional colleges of the University, the procedure for their convocation and decision-making, as well as issues of preparation and holding general meetings of the staff of professional colleges of the University, are determined by the Law of Ukraine "On Professional Pre-Higher Education" and the regulations on professional colleges of the University.

6.7. Student self-government

6.7.1. The University has a student self-government, which is an integral part of the public self-government of the University.

6.7.2. Participation in student self-government is the right and opportunity of all students studying at the University to participate in solving issues of education and life, protection of the rights and interests of students. Students have equal rights, can elect and be elected to elective, advisory, working and other bodies of student self-government of the University.

6.7.3. Student self-government ensures the protection of the rights and interests of students and their participation in the management of the University. Student self-government is carried out by students directly and through the executive bodies of student self-government, which are elected by direct secret ballot of students.

6.7.4. The structure, system, as well as issues within the competence of student self-government are determined by law, this Statute and the regulations on student self-government of the University.

6.7.5. Student self-government is carried out at the level of a student group, faculty (educational and scientific institute), professional college, dormitory, University.

6.7.6. Bodies of student self-government:

1) participate in the management of the University in the manner prescribed by law and this Statute;

2) participate in the discussion and resolution of issues of improving educational process, research work, scholarship appointments, leisure activities, recreation, living conditions and nutrition;

3) conduct organizational, educational, scientific, sports, recreational and other events;

4) participate in measures (processes) to ensure the quality of higher education;

5) protect the rights and interests of students studying at the University;

6) delegate their representatives to working, advisory bodies University;

7) adopt acts regulating their organization and activities;

8) participate in resolving issues of ensuring adequate living conditions students' accommodation in dormitories and organization of students' meals;

9) manage funds and other property that are on the balance sheet and bank accounts of student self-government bodies;

10) make proposals regarding the content of curricula and programs;

11) make proposals for the development of the material base at the University, including including issues related to the life and recreation of students;

12) have the right to declare protests;

13) perform other functions provided for by law and the Regulations on student self-government of the University.

6.7.7. Decisions are made in agreement with the student self-government body of the University regarding:

1) expulsion of students from the University and their reinstatement;

2) transfer of persons studying at the University under state order to contract studies at the expense of individuals (legal entities);

3) transfer of persons studying at the University at the expense of individuals (legal entities), to study under state order;

4) appointment of the deputy dean of the faculty, deputy director of educational

and scientific institute, professional college, vice-rector of the University;

5) settling in and eviction from the dormitory of persons studying at the University;

6) approval of the Internal Regulations of the University in the part that relates to persons studying;

7) activities of the student campus and dormitories for the residence of persons who are studying at the University;

8) regarding the resolution of other issues provided for by this Statute and the Regulations on student self-government of the University.

6.7.8. The highest body of student self-government is the meeting (conference) of students of the University, which:

1) approve the regulations on student self-government of the University, determine the structure, powers and procedure for direct secret elections of representative and executive bodies of student self-government;

2) hear reports of representative, executive and control and audit bodies of student self-government, give them an appropriate assessment;

3) approve the procedure for the use of property and funds of student bodies self-government, support for student initiatives on a competitive basis;

4) approve the annual estimate of expenses (budget) of student bodies self-government, make changes and additions to it, hear a report on its execution;

5) elect a control and audit commission from among students to carry out current control over the use of property and the execution of the budget of bodies student self-government.

6.7.9. The University administration has no right to interfere in the activities of bodies student self-government of the University.

6.7.10. The Rector of the University promotes and ensures proper conditions for the activities of student self-government bodies (provides premises, furniture, office equipment, provides telephone communication, permanent access to the Internet, allocates places for installation of information stands, etc.).

6.8. Scientific Society of Students, Postgraduates, Doctoral Students and Young Scientists

6.8.1. Scientific societies operate in the University and its structural divisions of students, postgraduates, doctoral students and young scientists as part of the public system self-government of the University.

6.8.2. Persons under the age of 35 (for doctoral students - up to 40 years) participate in the work of the scientific society of students, postgraduates, doctoral students and young scientists, who study or work at the University.

6.8.3. Scientific society of students, graduate students, doctoral students and young scientists ensures the protection of the rights and interests of persons studying or working at the University, in particular regarding scientific activities, support of science-intensive ideas, innovations and exchange of knowledge.

6.8.4. In its activities, the society is guided by legislation, this Statute and Regulations on the Scientific Society of Students, Graduate Students, Doctoral Students and Young Scientists.

6.8.5. The University administration has no right to interfere in the activities of scientific societies of students, graduate students, doctoral students and young scientists, except in cases where such activity contradicts the law, the charter or harms the interests of the University.

6.8.6. The Rector of the University comprehensively promotes the creation of appropriate conditions for activities of the scientific society of students, graduate students, doctoral students and young scientists (provides premises, furniture, office equipment, provides telephone communication, permanent access to the Internet, allocates places for the installation of information stands, etc.).

6.8.7. The financial basis of the activities of the scientific society of students, graduate students, doctoral students and young scientists are funds determined by the Academic Council.

## SECTION 7. ORGANIZATION OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROCESS AT THE UNIVERSITY AND ITS PARTICIPANTS

7.1. The educational process at the University is carried out in accordance with the requirements of legislation, normative documents of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine and acts of University.

7.2. The Regulations on the organization of the educational process at the University are approved by Academic Council.

7.3. The language of the educational process at the University is the state language. Application of languages at the University is determined by the laws of Ukraine "On ensuring the functioning of the Ukrainian language as the state language" and "On education".

The Academic Council of the University has the right to decide on the teaching of one, several or all disciplines, the implementation of individual tasks and the conduct of control measures in English, provided that all students studying relevant disciplines, are fluent in English. If there is a written request from one or more students, the University provides translation into the state language.

The language of scientific events of the University (scientific conferences, round tables, symposiums, seminars, scientific schools, etc.) may be the state language, English and/or other official languages of the European Union.

7.4. The main forms of higher education at the University are: institutional (full-time (day, evening), part-time, distance); dual.

The University may use other forms of higher education and combine forms of higher education in accordance with the regulations on the organization of educational process at the University, as well as establish requirements for combining forms of higher education.

7.5. Practical training of persons studying at the University is carried out by completing internships at enterprises, institutions and organizations in accordance with agreements concluded by the University or in its structural divisions that provide practical training.

7.6. Participants in the educational process at the University are:

- 1) scientific-pedagogical, scientific and pedagogical staff;
- 2) students of higher education and other persons studying at the University;
- 3) practitioners who are involved in the educational process on educational professional programs;
- 4) other employees of the University.

7.7. Employers may be involved in the educational process at the University, stakeholders of the University.

7.8. A complete list of positions of scientific-pedagogical and pedagogical staff is established by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine. The list of positions of scientific staff of the University is determined in accordance with the Law of Ukraine «On Scientific and Scientific technical activity».

7.9. The Rector of the University, scientific-pedagogical, scientific and pedagogical staff of the University (except for foreigners or stateless persons) are obliged to know the state language and use it in the performance of official duties. Requirements regarding the appropriate level of proficiency in the state language by

such persons is established by the Law of Ukraine «On ensuring the functioning of the Ukrainian language as the state language».

7.10. Positions of pedagogical staff may be held by persons with a master's degree (specialist) in the relevant specialty.

Pedagogical staff are appointed to and dismissed from their positions by the Rector of the University. Pedagogical staff undergo certification every five years. According to the results of the certification, the compliance of employees with the position held is determined, qualification categories, pedagogical titles are awarded.

The procedure for attestation of pedagogical staff is established by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine. The list of qualification categories and pedagogical titles of pedagogical staff is determined by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine.

7.11. Positions of scientific and pedagogical staff may be held by persons who have a scientific degree or academic title, as well as persons who have a master's degree.

7.12. Procedures and conditions for filling vacant positions of scientific and pedagogical scientific and other categories of University employees, as well as procedures and conditions for conducting a competitive selection of scientific and pedagogical staff of the University are determined by law, this Charter and the Procedure for conducting a competitive selection for filling vacant positions of scientific and pedagogical staff and concluding with them employment contracts (contracts).

7.13. When filling vacant positions of scientific and pedagogical staff - heads of departments, professors, associate professors, senior lecturers, lecturers, the conclusion of an employment contract (contract) is preceded by a competitive selection.

The University may conclude short-term employment contracts with foreign citizens in accordance with the law.

7.14. A person at the University may not hold two or more positions at the same time, which involve the performance of administrative and managerial functions.

7.15. Working hours, rights and obligations of scientific and pedagogical, scientific, pedagogical employees and persons studying at the University are determined by the Code of Labor Laws of Ukraine, the Laws of Ukraine "On Education", "On Higher Education", "On Professional Pre-Higher Education" and other normative legal acts, this Statute, Internal Regulations, collective agreement, job instructions.

7.16. Scientific, pedagogical and scientific employees of the University have right to:

- 1) to academic freedom, which is realized in the interests of the individual, society and humanity in general;
- 2) for academic mobility to carry out professional activities;
- 3) participate in the management of the University, including electing and being elected as a delegate to the conference of the University's labor collective, the Scientific Council or its structural unit in accordance with the law and this Statute;
- 4) choose teaching methods and tools that ensure high quality educational process;
- 5) to ensure the creation of appropriate working conditions, improve their professional level, organization of recreation and life, established by law, regulations acts of the University, the terms of the individual employment contract and collective agreement;
- 6) free use of library, information resources, services educational, scientific, sports (in free time from work and educational process), cultural and educational units of the University;
- 7) for professional development and internships at least once every five years;
- 8) receive preferential long-term loans for construction (reconstruction) and purchase of housing in accordance with the established procedure;
- 9) for social and pension provision in accordance with the established procedure.

7.17. Scientific-pedagogical, scientific and pedagogical staff of the University have also other rights provided by law and this Statute.

7.18. Scientific-pedagogical, scientific and pedagogical staff of the University are obliged to:

- 1) ensure at a high scientific-theoretical and methodological level teaching of academic disciplines of the relevant educational program in the specialty (for scientific and pedagogical workers), to conduct scientific activities (for scientific and pedagogical, scientific workers);

2) improve professional level, pedagogical skills (for scientific pedagogical and pedagogical workers), scientific qualifications (for scientific pedagogical, scientific workers);

3) adhere to the norms of pedagogical ethics, morality, respect the honor and dignity of individuals who study at the University, instill in them love for Ukraine, educate them in the spirit of patriotism, national dignity and respect for the Constitution and laws of Ukraine, state symbols of Ukraine and the rules of social coexistence;

4) develop independence, initiative, in individuals studying at the University, creative abilities;

5) comply with the statute of the University and the law.

7.19. The Rector of the University, in accordance with the law, the statute and the collective agreement determines the procedure, establishes the amounts of surcharges, allowances, bonuses, material assistance and encouragement of scientific-pedagogical, scientific, pedagogical and other employees of the University.

7.20. Scientific-pedagogical and pedagogical staff improve their qualifications and undergo internships in Ukraine and abroad. The University provides advanced training and internships for scientific-pedagogical and pedagogical staff at least once every five years with the preservation of the average salary.

7.21. Dismissal of scientific-pedagogical and pedagogical staff in connection with changes in the organization of the educational process, changes in the scope of work and workload, reduction of the number of employees is carried out on the initiative of the administration of the University, unless otherwise provided by the employment contract (contract).

Dismissal of other employees, as well as scientific-pedagogical and pedagogical employees on other grounds is carried out in accordance with the procedure established by law.

7.22. Persons studying at the University are:

- 1) higher education applicants;
- 2) professional pre-higher education applicants;
- 3) other persons studying at the University.

7.23. Higher education applicants are:

1) student – a person enrolled in the University for the purpose of obtaining higher education a junior bachelor's, bachelor's or master's degree;

2) postgraduate student – a person enrolled in the University to obtain a doctoral degree of philosophy.

7.24. Professional pre-higher education applicants are students – persons enrolled in a professional college of the University for the purpose of obtaining professional pre-higher education.

7.25. Other persons studying at the University include a listener – a person who studies at the University in the preparatory department or in advanced training programs qualifications, as well as a person who receives additional or separate educational services.

7.26. Persons studying at the University have the right to:

1) choosing the form of education from the forms of higher education offered by the institution obtaining education under the relevant educational programs;

2) safe and harmless conditions of study, work and life;

3) labor activity in non-study time;

4) free use of libraries, information funds, educational, scientific and sports facilities of the University;

5) free provision of information for training in accessible formats from using technologies that take into account the limitations of life, due to health status (for persons with special educational needs);

6) use of production, cultural, educational, household, health-improving bases of the University in the manner prescribed by the University;

7) provision of a dormitory and round-the-clock access to it for the period of study in the manner established by law and acts of the University;

8) participation in research, development and design works, conferences, symposiums, exhibitions, competitions, presentation of their works for publication;

9) participation in the discussion and resolution of issues of improving the educational process, research work, appointment of scholarships, organization of leisure, life, health improvement;

10) participation in the activities of public self-government bodies and collegiate bodies management of the University and its structural subdivisions, student bodies self-government;

11) studying simultaneously under several educational programs, as well as in several higher education institutions, provided that only one higher education qualification is obtained for each level at the expense of the state (local) budget;

12) academic mobility, including international;

13) other rights defined by law and this Statute.

7.27. Individuals studying at the University in a full-time form of education at the expense of state budget funds are entitled to receive academic and social scholarships in accordance with the procedure established by law. Individuals studying at The University may receive other scholarships awarded by individuals (legal entities) persons. Social scholarships are awarded to students of the University in accordance with established by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine. Academic scholarships are awarded persons who have achieved significant success in their studies and/or scientific activities in accordance with criteria established by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine. The size of the academic and social scholarships, the procedure for their appointment and payment are established by the Cabinet Ministers of Ukraine.

7.28. Individuals studying at the University are obliged to:

1) comply with the requirements of legislation, this Statute and the Internal Regulations of the University;

2) comply with the requirements for labor protection, safety, industrial sanitation, fire safety, provided for by the relevant rules and instructions;

3) fulfill the requirements of the educational program (individual curriculum), adhering to academic integrity, and achieve the defined for the appropriate level higher education learning outcomes.

7.29. The procedure for expulsion, interruption of studies, renewal and transfer of persons, who study at the University is carried out in accordance with the requirements of the law.

## SECTION 8. INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AND FOREIGN ECONOMIC ACTIVITY

7.1. The University carries out international cooperation on the principles of integration of the system higher education and science of Ukraine into the world and European space, the introduction of the latest technologies of educational, scientific, scientific-technical and innovative activities, exchange of scientific ideas, developments, knowledge, experience, etc., training highly qualified, competitive specialists and their education on universal and European values, while preserving and developing achievements and progressive traditions of the national higher school.

7.2. The legal personality of the University as a participant in international cooperation is based on the legislation of Ukraine and is implemented through the conclusion of agreements (memorandums) with foreign partners on cooperation, international academic mobility, foreign economic activity, etc. in compliance with the norms and generally recognized principles of international law.

7.3. The tasks of the University in the field of international cooperation are:

- 1) establishing, maintaining and developing friendly mutually beneficial relations with educational institutions, foundations, scientific institutions of foreign countries, international organizations, foreign legal entities, individual entrepreneurs and individuals;
- 2) deepening international cooperation in the fields of education, science, sports, arts and culture;
- 3) increasing the level of integration into the global educational and scientific space;
- 4) attracting funds from international foundations, institutions, public organizations, etc. for the implementation of scientific, educational and other programs;
- 5) dissemination at the international level of the results of scientific, technical, technological and other developments of the University;
- 6) development of international project activities.

7.4. In order to integrate into the European Higher Education Area and the global educational system, the University:

- 1) establishes direct links with educational institutions, scientific institutions, enterprises and organizations of foreign countries, concludes agreements (agreements, memorandums) on cooperation, implements joint

international projects, acquires membership in associations and other interstate associations of higher education institutions;

2) participates in competitions for grants from foreign and international foundations, non-governmental organizations in order to implement joint educational and research programs;

3) promotes academic mobility of students, graduate students, doctoral students and scientific and pedagogical staff within the framework of international treaties of Ukraine, international projects based on a contractual basis, and agreements concluded by the University with educational and scientific institutions of foreign countries;

4) exchanges information on education, if it does not contradict legislation, exchange of scientific publications, educational and methodological materials, bibliographic and reference literature;

5) organizes and participates in international conferences, symposia and other events;

6) invites foreign teachers and specialists to participate in the educational process, scientific work and project activities;

7) in accordance with the legislation of foreign countries, it may form its structural subdivisions on the territory of these states;

8) creates joint educational and scientific programs with foreign higher education institutions, scientific institutions, organizations, etc.

7.1. Foreign economic activity of the University is carried out in accordance with legislation by concluding contracts (agreements, memorandums) with foreign legal entities and individuals and is carried out in the following forms:

1) organization of training of persons from among foreign citizens and stateless persons for admission to the University and persons from among citizens of Ukraine to study abroad;

2) carrying out educational activities related to the training of foreign students under accredited educational programs, as well as training of scientific personnel for foreign countries;

3) organization of studying abroad;

4) performance of scientific research and scientific and technical developments;

5) provision of consulting services to foreign organizations, institutions;

6) attraction of foreign investments in accordance with the established procedure, charitable contributions and donations;

7) implementation of other types of foreign economic activity not prohibited by law.

8) 6. The University ensures the implementation of activities related to the identification/recognition of higher education degrees obtained in foreign higher education institutions related to the identification/recognition of higher education degrees obtained in foreign higher education institutions and/or completed periods of study and recognition of educational documents, etc.

8.7. The University is liable for its obligations arising during the implementation of international cooperation and foreign economic activity, in the manner prescribed by law.

8.8. Representation of the University in the areas of international cooperation and foreign economic activity is carried out by the rector.

## SECTION 9. SCIENTIFIC, SCIENTIFIC-TECHNICAL AND INNOVATIVE ACTIVITY OF THE UNIVERSITY

7.1. Scientific, scientific-technical and innovation activity is an integral part of the educational activity of the University and is carried out in order to integrate scientific, educational and production activities in the higher education system. The implementation of scientific and scientific-technical activities by the University is mandatory.

7.2. Subjects of scientific, scientific-technical and innovation activity of the University are scientific, scientific-pedagogical staff, persons studying at the University, other employees of the University, as well as employees of enterprises that jointly with the University carry out scientific, scientific-technical and innovation activities.

7.3. The main goal of scientific, scientific-technical and innovation activity of the University is to obtain new scientific knowledge through scientific research and development and their direction to the creation and implementation of new competitive technologies, types of equipment, materials, etc. to ensure innovative development of society, training of specialists of innovative type.

7.4. The main tasks of scientific, scientific-technical and innovative activity of the University are:

- 1) obtaining competitive scientific and scientific-applied results;
- 2) application of new scientific, scientific and technical knowledge during training of specialists with higher education;
- 3) formation of a modern scientific personnel potential capable of ensuring development and implementation of innovative scientific projects;
- 4) carrying out scientific activities by conducting scientific research and ensuring the creative activity of participants in the educational process, training scientific personnel of higher qualification and use of the results obtained in the educational process;
- 5) conducting fundamental and applied scientific research, scientific and technical developments that meet the priority directions of science and technology for the creation and implementation of new competitive technologies, types of equipment, materials, etc. to ensure the innovative development of society;
- 6) support and development of scientific schools for the training of innovative specialists type;
- 7) obtaining competitive scientific and scientific-applied results; application of new scientific, scientific and technical knowledge during the training of specialists with higher education; formation of a modern scientific personnel potential capable of ensuring the development and implementation of innovative scientific developments;
- 8) ensuring integration into the world educational and scientific space, in particular participation in international projects, creation of intellectual property objects, joint scientific projects, grants, etc. while preserving and developing the achievements and traditions of Ukrainian higher education;
- 9) implementation of a full cycle of scientific and technical activity - from fundamental, exploratory research to the implementation of developments in practice;
- 10) development of scientific and scientific-technical creativity of persons studying at University.

7.5. Integration of scientific, scientific-technical and innovative activities of the University is carried out in order to develop and implement priority scientific programs, conducting scientific research, experimental development, etc. on the basis of combining personnel, financial, technical and organizational resources in accordance with legislation.

7.6. Scientific, scientific-technical and innovative activity of the University is provided through:

- 1) implementation in accordance with the established procedure of state budget, economic contract, scientific research and development works, as well as works financed by at the expense of attracted funds of enterprises, institutions and organizations, funds of domestic and foreign customers of works, grants, other sources not prohibited by law;
- 2) integration of scientific, scientific-technical and innovative activities with scientific institutions of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine, national branch academies sciences;
- 3) development of various forms of scientific cooperation with higher education institutions and other institutions and organizations for solving scientific problems, implementing the results scientific research, development, etc.;
- 4) preparation of monographs, textbooks, teaching aids, scientific articles and other works of science, taking into account the latest achievements of science and technology;
- 5) organization and participation in scientific, scientific-practical, scientific-methodical conferences, seminars, olympiads, competitions, etc., implementation of research, course, diploma, master's works of participants in the educational process;
- 6) conducting scientific and scientific-technical expertise, expert research, provision of scientific and scientific-technical services in accordance with the law.

7.7. The University independently implements the policy of scientific, scientific-technical and innovative activity on the principles of autonomy. The University has all the rights granted to scientific institutions of Ukraine in the field of organization of scientific research, is responsible for the quality research and development.

7.8. Scientific and scientific-technical works at the University may involve scientific and pedagogical, scientific and pedagogical workers, other employees, persons who study at the University, as well as employees of other institutions and organizations.

7.9. Scientific works are performed by departments, research and other divisions of the University, scientific teams, individual scientists, persons studying at the University, other employees of the University under contracts, state orders, sectoral, intersectoral and other programs and projects and grants.

7.10. To ensure the effectiveness of scientific research, their harmonious combination with the educational process and implementation in law enforcement, The University monitors the implementation of research activities in accordance with the plans approved by the Academic Council of the University.

7.11. In order to publicize the results of scientific research at the University an information scientific resource is created (collections of scientific works, a series of bulletins of the University, scientific journals, monographs and other publications, electronic educational complexes), scientific and scientific-practical conferences, seminars, meetings are held round table", competitions of scientific works, exhibitions of scientific literature and other events.

7.12. Scientific, scientific-technical and innovative activities may be carried out in that including legal entities created by the University, the subject of which is proving the results of scientific and scientific-technical activity of the University to the state of innovative product and its further commercialization.

7.13. The University may conduct joint scientific research, demonstration experiments, etc., including using land plots that are in permanent use of the University, provided that the University is the founder innovative structures of various types (scientific and technological parks, business incubators, etc.).

7.14. Acquisition, protection and defense of the rights of the University and participants in the educational process regarding the results of scientific, scientific-technical and other activities are ensured in accordance with the law.

The University has the right to dispose of property rights of intellectual property to objects of intellectual property rights.

The University's expenses incurred in connection with ensuring legal protection on objects of intellectual property rights, property rights to which are acquired in the established procedure established by law, are carried out at the expense of the University's own revenues.

7.15. Scientific research at the University is carried out in accordance with the regulations on organization of research work at the University, plans of scientific research works and the regulation on the policy of open science of the University. Scientific and scientific-technical research is financed from the funds of the state budget, the University's own revenues and other sources in accordance with legislation.

7.16. The University creates conditions for conducting research work students, graduate students, doctoral students and young scientists, their internships in leading Ukrainian and foreign Universities and scientific institutions.

7.17. The University takes measures to prevent academic plagiarism - publication (in part or in full) of scientific (creative) results obtained by other persons, as results of own research (creativity) and/or reproduction published texts of other authors without indicating authorship in accordance with the current provisions of the university.

7.18. Scientific, scientific-technical and innovative activities are carried out by the University in accordance with the requirements of the laws of Ukraine "On Education", "On Higher Education", "On Scientific and Scientific-Technical Activity", "On Innovation Activity" and other normative legal acts.

## SECTION 10. SOURCES OF REVENUE AND PROCEDURE FOR USE OF FUNDS AND PROPERTY OF THE UNIVERSITY

10.1. The material and technical base of the University consists of buildings, dormitories, structures, land, communications, equipment, vehicles and other tangible assets.

10.2. In accordance with the legislation and in order to ensure the statutory activities of the University, the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine assigns on the basis of the right of economic management or transfers to ownership buildings, structures, property complexes, communications, equipment, vehicles and other property.

Land use and realization of the rights of the owner of land plots, including acquisition and termination of relevant land rights, are carried out by the University in accordance with the Land Code of Ukraine.

The powers of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine regarding the disposal of property of the University are exercised in accordance with the law.

10.3. Property is assigned to the University on the right of economic management and is not may be the subject of a pledge, and is also not subject to seizure, alienation, privatization or use for other than its intended purpose, transfer to the ownership of legal or natural persons without the consent of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine and the conference of the labor collective of the University, except as provided by law.

10.4. Buildings, structures and premises of the University must meet the requirements accessibility in accordance with state building codes and standards. If relevant objects cannot be fully adapted to the needs of persons with special

educational needs, their reasonable adaptation is carried out taking into account the universal design.

Design, construction and reconstruction of buildings, structures and premises The university is carried out taking into account the needs of persons with special educational needs.

10.5. The University, in the manner determined by law, and in accordance with this The Statute has the right to:

- 1) ownership of intellectual property rights created at its own expense or funds from the state or local budgets (except in cases determined by law);
- 2) establish a sustainable fund (endowment) of the University and dispose of income from its use in accordance with the terms of operation of the sustainable fund, as well as receive property, funds and material assets, including buildings, structures, equipment, vehicles, from state bodies, local self-government bodies, legal entities and individuals, including as charitable assistance;
- 3) carry out financial and economic activities in Ukraine and abroad;
- 4) use the property assigned to it on the right of economic management, in including for carrying out economic activities, transferring it for rent and in use in accordance with the law;
- 5) create its own or use under contract other material and technical bases for carrying out educational, scientific, innovative or economic activities;
- 6) create and develop its own base of social and household facilities, a network sports and recreation, medical and preventive and cultural and artistic structural subdivisions;
- 7) carry out capital construction, reconstruction, carry out capital and current repair of fixed assets;
- 8) direct funds to social support of scientific and pedagogical, scientific, pedagogical and other employees of the University and persons studying at the University;
- 9) open current and deposit accounts in national and foreign currencies in accordance with the law;

10) participate in the formation of the authorized capital of innovative structures and small enterprises established with the participation of higher education institutions that develop and implement innovative products by contributing intangible assets to them (property rights to intellectual property rights);

11) establish educational institutions and scientific institutions;

12) establish enterprises for innovation and/or production activities;

13) make transfers in foreign currency of contributions for collective membership in international educational and scientific associations, as well as for subscriptions to foreign scientific publications and access to global information networks and databases;

14) by contributing intangible assets (property rights to objects of law intellectual property) participate in the formation of the authorized capital of innovative structures of various types (scientific, technological parks, business incubators, etc.).

10.6. The University is financed from the following funds:

1) general fund for the training of specialists within the state order and conducting research work;

2) a special fund, which is formed from: income from the provision of paid educational services; income from economic activities, payment for rent of premises and property; funds received for training, retraining, advanced training specialists, providing additional educational services in accordance with agreements concluded with legal entities and individuals; other income in accordance with the law.

10.7. The University's own revenues, received from payment for services that are provided in accordance with educational, scientific and educational-production activities, charitable contributions and grants in accordance with the decision adopted by the Academic Council of the University, are credited to special registration accounts opened in the territorial body of the central executive body in the field of treasury services budget funds, or to current and/or deposit (deposit) accounts of state institutions banks.

These incomes, as well as interest received from the placement of the University's funds on deposit (deposit) accounts in state banking institutions, are included in the University's budget and can be used for the purchase of property and its use, capital construction and repair of premises, improvement of material technical,

educational-laboratory, educational-methodical support of educational process, etc. within the statutory activities of the University.

10.8. Funds from the general and special funds of the budget are directed to implementation of statutory activities for specific purposes for current and capital University expenses within the allocated limits of budget allocations and estimates, which are approved by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

10.9. University income is used exclusively to finance expenses

10.10. for the maintenance of the University, the implementation of statutory tasks and the achievement of the goals of the University.

It is forbidden to distribute the received income or parts thereof among the founders, employees of the University (except for payment of their salaries, accrual of a single social contribution), members of the University's governing bodies and other related persons.

10.11. Funds received by the University as payment for training, preparation, retraining, advanced training of personnel or for the provision of educational services, cannot be withdrawn into the income of the state or local budgets.

10.12. The University, in accordance with the law and this Statute, may provide paid services to individuals and legal entities, provided that they provide an adequate level of educational services as the main statutory activity.

10.13. The University may provide paid services in the manner prescribed by law. The list of paid educational and other services that can be provided by the University as a state institution of higher education is approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine.

10.14. The University has the right to provide additional paid educational and other services exclusively outside the activities financed from the funds of the relevant budgets or according to contracts concluded between the University and an individual (legal) entity, which orders a paid educational service.

10.15. Paid educational services can be provided by the same structural subdivisions that carry out the educational process under state order, or separate structural subdivisions created to provide paid services of the University, operating on the basis of regulations approved in accordance with legislation and the Statute of the University.

10.16. The University independently manages its own revenues, received from the provision of paid services, works and other activities permitted by law types of economic activity.

## SECTION 11. PROCEDURE FOR REPORTING AND CONTROL OVER THE IMPLEMENTATION FINANCIAL AND ECONOMIC ACTIVITIES

11.1. The University, as a budgetary institution and a non-profit institution of higher education, which is maintained at the expense of the state budget, compiles approved forms monthly, quarterly and annual reports and submits reports in accordance with the requirements of the law.

11.2. The University independently carries out operational, accounting and financial accounting of its work, maintains statistical reporting, submits information at the request of bodies to whom the law grants the right to control the relevant areas of activity.

11.3. The Rector and the Chief Accountant of the University are personally responsible for the reliability of the accounting and statistical reporting of the University.

11.4. The audit of the University's activities is carried out in accordance with the law.

11.5. The estimate for the current year and all changes to it, a report on the use and receipt of funds, information on tendering procedures, staffing schedule for the current year, the target indicators of the University, the achievement of which must ensure the rector in accordance with the contract, the terms of their achievement and the method of verification achieving such target indicators are published on the University's website.

11.6. The Statute and other documents of the University, which regulate the procedure implementation of the educational process, information on the composition of its governing bodies, as well as the budget of the University and the annual, including financial, report are published on the official website of the University.

11.7. State supervision (control) over compliance by the University with legislation in the field of education and science and standards of educational activity is carried out by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine by exercising state supervision (control) over its activities.

## SECTION 12. PROCEDURE FOR AMENDING THE STATUTE

12.1. The Statute of the University is agreed upon by the conference of the labor collective of the University upon submission by the Academic Council of the University and submitted to the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine for approval.

12.2. Amendments and additions to the Statute of the University are made by stating it in a new edition and approved in the same manner as the Statute itself.

## SECTION 13. PROCEDURE FOR LIQUIDATION AND REORGANIZATION OF THE UNIVERSITY

13.1. Liquidation and reorganization (merger, accession, division, transformation) The university is carried out in accordance with the law.

13.2. The liquidation of the University is carried out by the liquidation commission, which is created by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine. The liquidation commission includes representatives of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine and the University. Order liquidation, as well as the deadline for creditors to submit their claims to the University, which is terminated, are determined by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.
