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Description of the discipline

The discipline "Administrative and Tort Law" covers a detailed study of the articles of the Code of Administrative Offenses, mastering the mechanism of bringing to administrative responsibility, the subjects authorized to consider cases of administrative offenses, the terms of bringing to administrative procedure, as well as mastering the specifics of bringing to administrative responsibility for certain types of administrative violations (in particular, related to corruption).

Upon completion of the discipline "Administrative Tort Law", students can freely operate with their theoretical and applied knowledge of the general principles and principles of the Code of Administrative Offenses, be able to draw up basic procedural documents, in particular, statements on the merits of the case, other statements and petitions, navigate the procedure for bringing to administrative responsibility, correctly apply appropriate means of protecting rights and interests, etc.
